- **Chairman's Report**

- **Covid**

OUTDOOR SHOOTING	
COACHING	1:1 permitted; Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted. Coaches must be masked.
TARGET BOSSES	Minimum spacing of boss centres of 3.66m
CLUB SESSIONS	Up to 2 archers or 1 household/bubble per target boss – always maintaining 2m social distancing and collecting own arrows
BEGINNERS	Have a Go's (Shows) – not permitted; Taster Sessions (1-2 hrs) & Beginners Courses – Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted*

- **Membership**

Discussion took place on club fees. It was agreed by a vote club fees would be increased to: -

- Adult (over 18) £100.00 per year or £9.50 per month (£114). (By Standing Order\*)
- Junior £50.00 per year or £4.50 per month (£54).
- Non-Shooting Adult Member £20 per year

Club nights will have the current equipment hire and shoot fees scrapped for a flat fee of £7.00 per Adult or £5.00 per Junior.
